Earn LEED Accredited Professional Designation**

(CSI), and Matt Greenwood, Project Manager and Estimator of tenant fit-outs and renovation projects, have earned the LEED-Existing Buildings Accredited Professional designation in the U.S. Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) program.

The LEED Green Building Rating System™ is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED Accredited Professionals have demonstrated a thorough understanding of green building practices and principles and familiarity with LEED requirements, resources, and processes.

LEED for Existing Buildings (EB) helps building owners and operators measure operation, improvements and maintenance on a consistent scale, with the goal of maximizing operational efficiency while minimizing environmental impacts. It addresses whole-building cleaning and maintenance issues (including chemical use), recycling programs, exterior maintenance programs, and systems upgrades. It can be applied both to existing buildings seeking LEED certification for the first time and to projects previously certified under LEED for New Construction, Schools, or Core & Shell.

“Buildings in the United States consume more than 30% of our total energy and more than 60% of our electricity annually. Building owners and managers have become more aware of the potential cost savings that can be achieved by incorporating LEED initiatives into their building operations and renovations,” said JD Flaherty, Jr., LEED AP and CSI President. “The LEED accreditation

process is important to CSI as we participate in many renovation projects each year. CSI wants to make sure we are supporting our clients with leading energy efficiency technologies and building renovation approaches.”

Flaherty and Greenwood both participated in the 8-week preparation class developed by the Central Ohio Chapter of the International Facility Management Association (IFMA). The LEED-EB exam is extremely challenging and the preparation course was critically important in the preparation process. Flaherty serves as President of the Central Ohio IFMA Chapter.
